

Installing Mouse Tracks Web Version 7.0

Prerequisites

- Operating System: Windows 2003 Server, Windows XP, Windows Vista or Windows 2008 Server
- IIS: Version 6 or 7
- NET Framework: [Version 3.5](#)
- Mouse Tracks Database: Version 7.0 (Mouse Tracks 2009 format)

Installation

1. Launch the MT_WEB_700.exe file and follow the on screen instructions.
2. Configure the database connection string in the web.config file
 - Using Windows Explorer, browse to the location of the installed files (default is c:\Program Files\Gritware\Mouse Tracks Web)
 - Right Click on the file web.config and choose "Open With"
 - Select Notepad.exe or another text editor to open the web.config file.
 - Find the Section labeled ***** CONFIGURE DATABASE CONNECTION *****
 - In this section you will see 4 example database connection strings.
 - Modify one of the connection strings to connect to your Mouse Tracks database. Examples 1 and 2 are Microsoft Access Database Connection Strings. Examples. Examples 3 and 4 are SQL Server Connection String Examples.
 - When modifying the connection string be sure to set the name="mtracks" for the connection string you wish to use.
 - IMPORTANT: The MtrackBE.mdb file must be physically located on the IIS Server (Access Database Only).
 - Give the ASPNET account on the IIS Server modify permissions to the database (MtrackBE.mdb) AND folder where the database resides (Access Databases Only).
3. Open your web browser to "http://IIS-ServerName/MtWeb"
4. Logon to Mouse Tracks Web
5. Configure Settings available under the Tools menu option.

Upgrade Information

Installing Mouse Tracks Web 7.0 will uninstall version 6.5.x (if applicable). Version 7.0 uses a virtual directory rather than the IIS root folder for its installation. The virtual directory's name is MtWeb.

If you had an Access database in the App_Data Folder from a prior installation you will need to move the file from (C:\inetpub\wwwroot\MouseTracksWeb\App_Data) to the new location (C:\Program Files\Gritware\Mouse Tracks Web\App_Data).
